

Lexington R-V School District Hall of Fame for Career Achievement

Nomination Form

The Lexington R-V School District *Hall of Fame for Career Achievement* honors alumni, past staff members and patrons who have distinguished themselves through their accomplishments and service and have brought great pride to the Lexington School District.

Nominees must have graduated from Lexington High School or the Douglass School at least ten (10) years prior to induction or staff must have left or retired from the district (including the Douglass School) at least five (5) years prior or be patrons who have made significant contributions to the school district. Both living and deceased alumni/staff/patrons may be considered for induction into the Hall of Fame. Selection will be based upon leadership, character, achievement, service, and suitability as a role model. The candidate cannot be a member of the current Hall of Fame Committee.

The Lexington School District Hall of Fame Committee and Board of Education have adopted the following guidelines for the Hall of Fame selection process.

- Distinction in service to a profession such as law, medicine, education
- Exceptional success in trade, business, industry or government
- High achievement in a recognized field of cultural endeavor such as art, music, theatre
- Outstanding achievement in activities
- Significant contributions to the community, state, or country

To nominate a person for Hall of Fame for Career Achievement consideration, the nominator must complete the following form and return it to: Lexington R-V Public Schools Administration Office at 2323A High School Drive, Lexington, MO 64067. (Attention: Hall of Fame for Career Achievement Committee)

The nominator can be anyone who can attest to the qualifications of the person he or she is nominating except the nominator shall not be a member of the nominee's immediate family.

The nominee shall flow through a selection process by the Hall of Fame Committee. When approved, selected nominee will be presented to the Lexington Board of Education for review and consideration. If approved, the nominee(s) will be inducted into the Hall of Fame.

The Hall of Fame selection process will be repeated each year. Nominations must be received by June 1st of each calendar year. Nominations will be kept on file for five (5) years.
