

Lexington Middle School

Morning Arrival at LMS

- The front doors on the east end of the building will open at 7:15 a.m. and students who are dropped off by a parent or guardian will come in to the commons to eat breakfast.
- Any student who rides or walks to school will enter the building on the west side on or after 7:15 a.m. All bicycles may be parked and locked outside on the rack. The school is not responsible for any loss.
- Students who ride the bus will be dropped off at the north end of the building by the library around 7:30-7:36 a.m. Students will walk into the building through the north doors and down the hallway to the commons where they will be served breakfast.

Afternoon Dismissal

Bus Riders

- The school buses will begin to arrive at the middle school between 2:35 and 2:40 p.m. and will pull around the north side of the building.
- At 2:45 p.m. bus riders will be dismissed through the north doors of the building and they will get on their bus.
- Buses will typically leave the school by 2:50-2:55 p.m.

Walkers

- There will be a crossing guard at the northwest corner of the building for all walkers and bike riders.
- No walker should ever leave on the north, east, or south sides of the building! There will be buses and cars in these areas, but there will not be a crossing guard!
- Students will be escorted across the street on the northwest corner and they will travel west along High School Drive.

Car Riders

- All parent pick-ups will exit the school from the west doors along the back of the building.
- Parents will enter the school parking lot from the southeast corner and drive around the backside to pick-up children
- Students are not allowed to load on the south side of the school. They must be picked up from the west side with a teacher/staff member present.
- Our staff is there to supervise students as they get in their cars to ensure their safety.
- Parents need to pull their vehicle up and fill in the gaps between cars, so we can load several students at once.
