
Welcome to our Title I Virtual Open House

Title 1 is the largest federally-funded program in education, designed to help students having difficulties with reading and/or mathematics by providing funds for extra attention, as well as materials and teachers.


Leslie Bell School is an approved schoolwide Title I program. This means we can provide ALL LBS students with support and assistance.



Our family loves music, traveling, and spending time with family and friends. I also enjoy scrapbooking and, of course...reading!


