

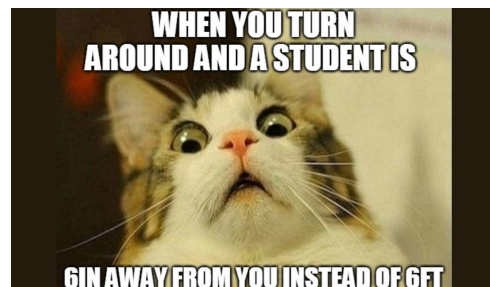
Welcome to Mr. Morgan's English/Language Arts Class!

Classroom Information and Expectations: My goal for the 2020-2021 school year is to create a positive and safe learning environment for all of my students. Due to Covid-19, I will be taking extra precautions in my classroom to help keep everyone safe and healthy. Masks **will be required** in my classroom, as I have too many desks to space out six feet apart. Students will also have assigned seats and will be expected to remain in their seat for the duration of the hour. While I don't normally assign seats, it is necessary this year to prevent unnecessary exposure to germs and to allow for contact tracing of students if necessary.

Most assignments will be done using this platform. I plan to keep assignments relatively consistent for in-person and virtual learners.
