# MEET YOUR TEACHER

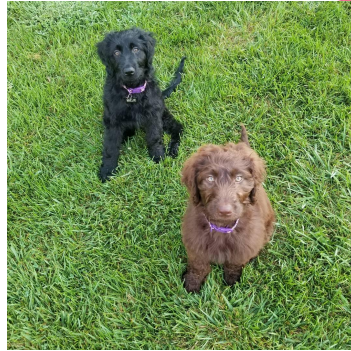

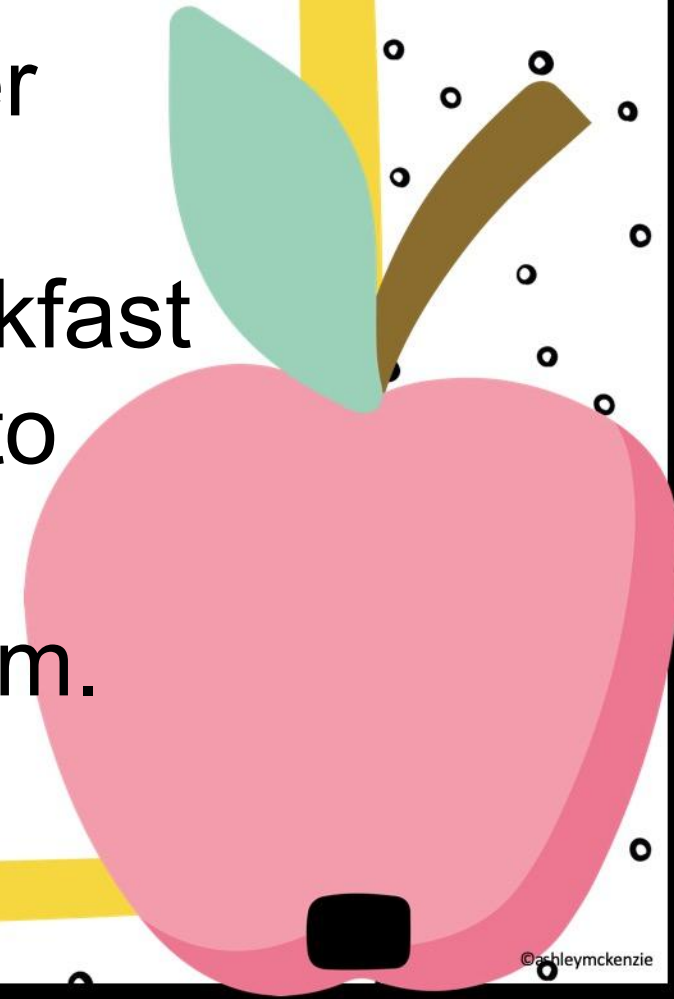
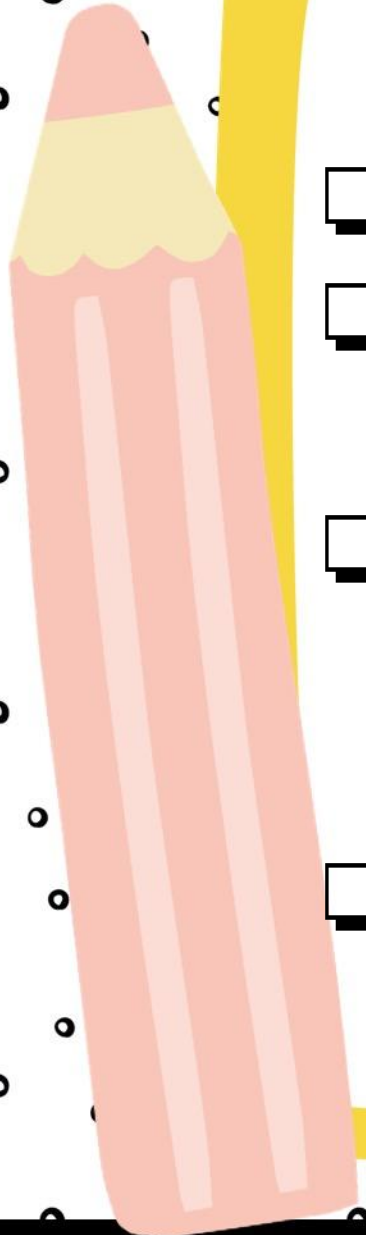

# ARRIVAL

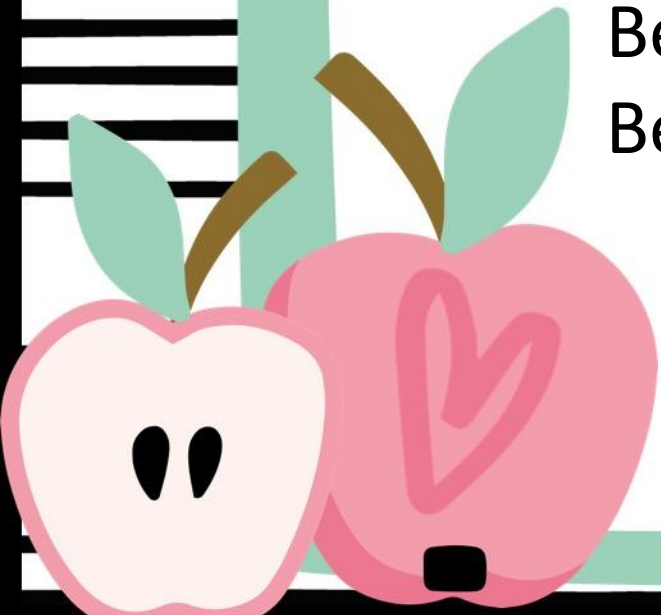
- ❑ LBS doors open at 7:35 am.

- Be Kind



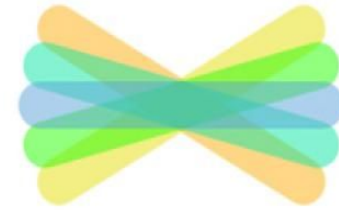
# TAKE-HOME FOLDER

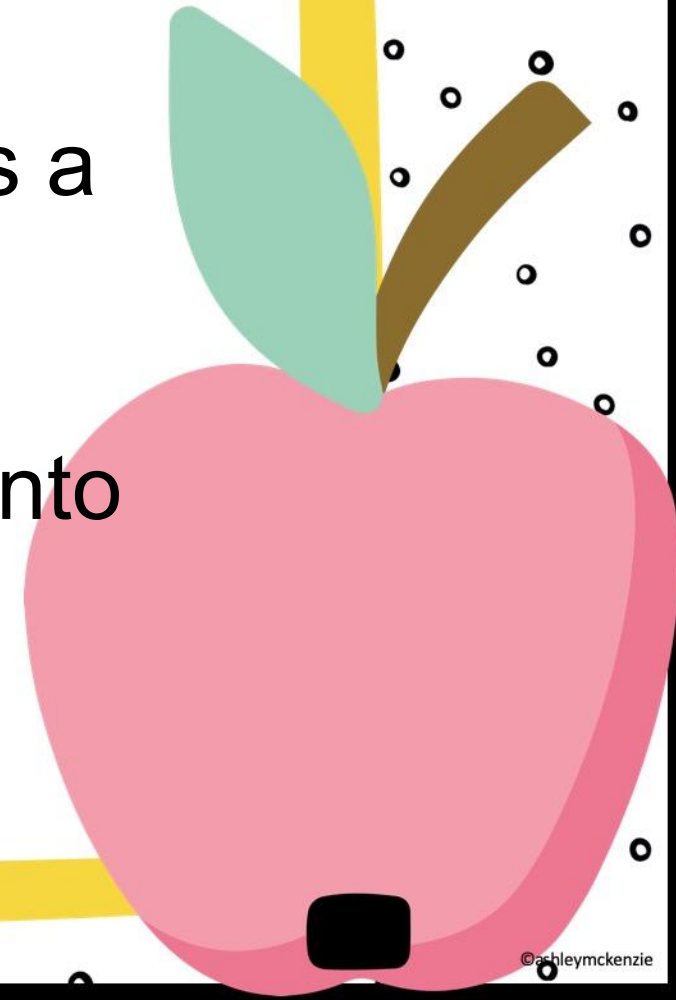
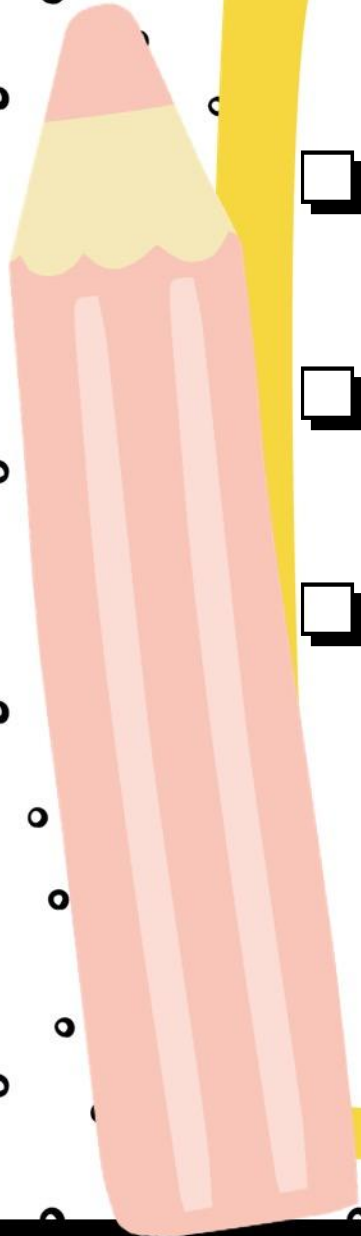
# TECH INFO

# DISMISSAL

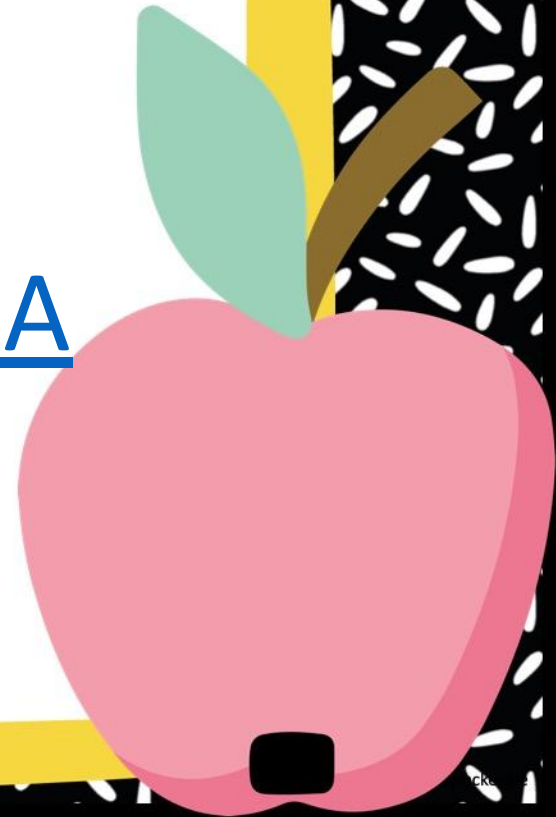
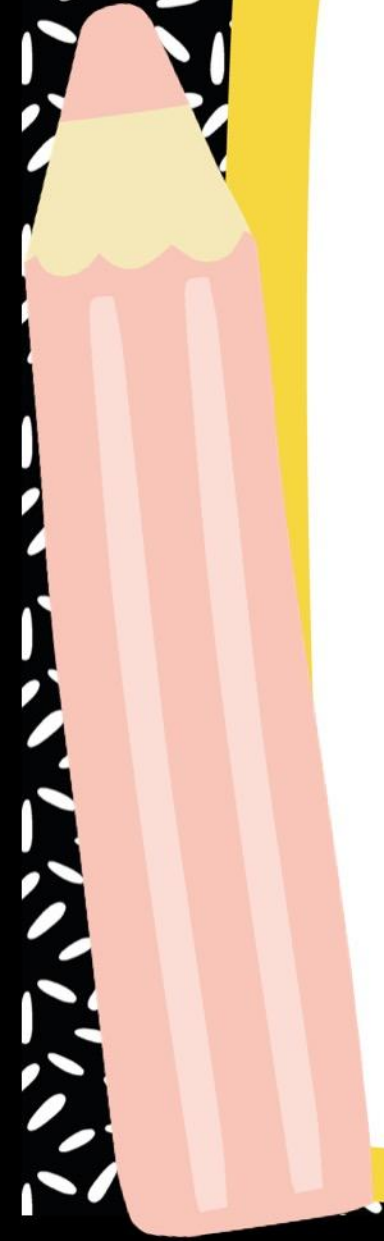
If your child's transportation to home changes, a message to me or a call to the office is required for the change to take place. Please call at least an hour before school is dismissed.

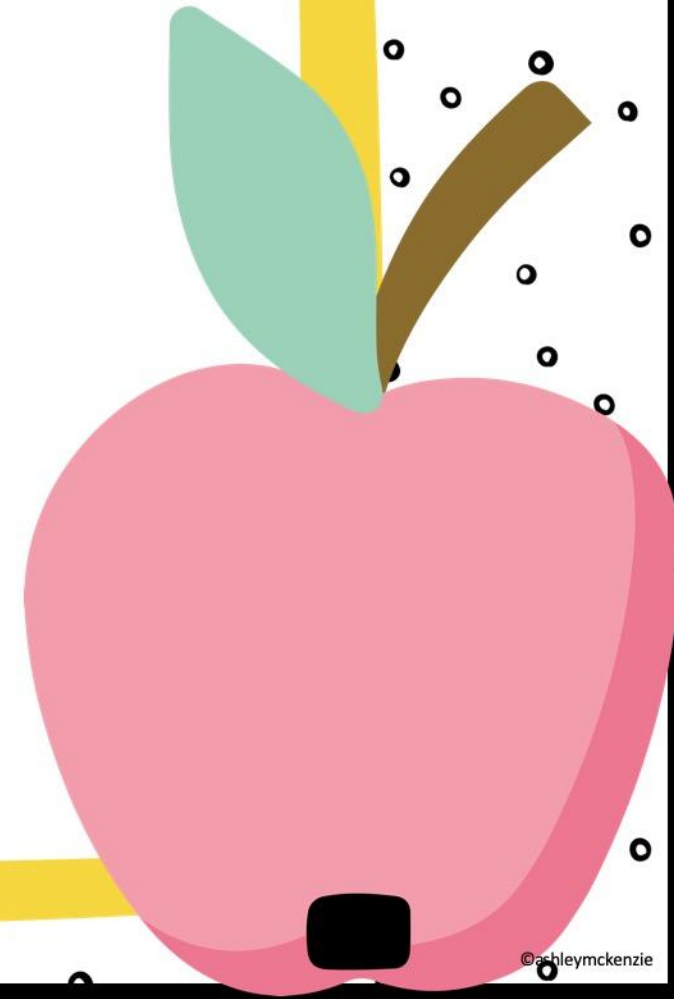
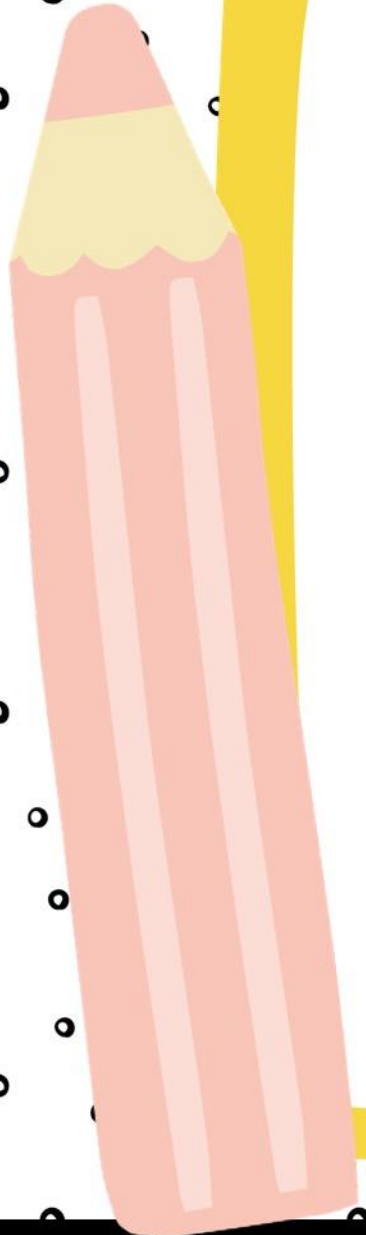
