# ARRIVAL

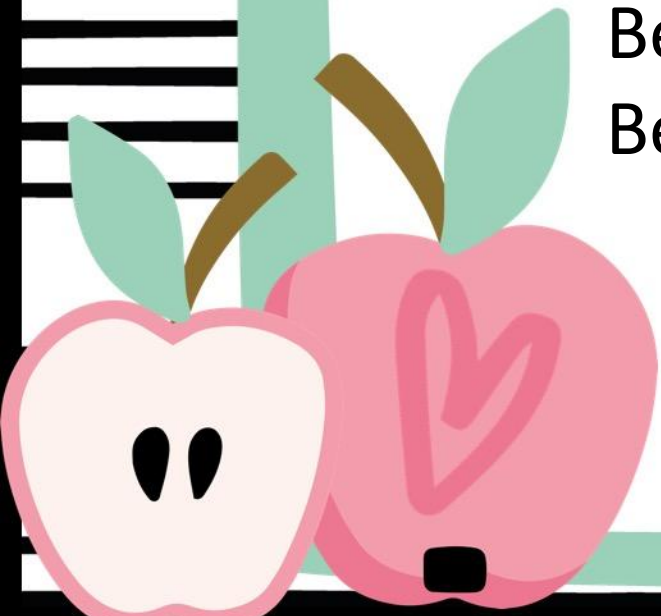
- ❑ LBS doors open at 7:35 am.

This binder is also where you can send lunch money and notes back to school. Please help your child to remember to take this binder out each evening to share their day with you, and place it back in their backpack for the following school day.

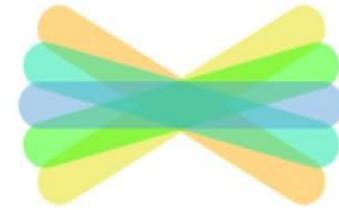
# STAR BINDER

## S.T.A.R. Binder Rules

1.	Keep your S.T.A.R. binder clean. Do not eat or drink while using it.	
2.	Take your S.T.A.R. binder home every day and bring it to school each morning.	
3.	Show your S.T.A.R. binder to your parents each day and share the contents with them.	
4.	Keep your S.T.A.R. binder away from younger brothers and sisters. Do not let anyone borrow, tear, or draw pictures in it. Remember it is YOURS!	
5.	Keep only papers that your teacher tells you to in your S.T.A.R. binder. Keep all other papers out. Your teacher will tell you when to replace papers.	
6.	Use your S.T.A.R. binder for school only. Don't color or tear any pages in the book!

We will be eating lunch in the classroom. Please have your child practice opening their own lunch as much as possible.





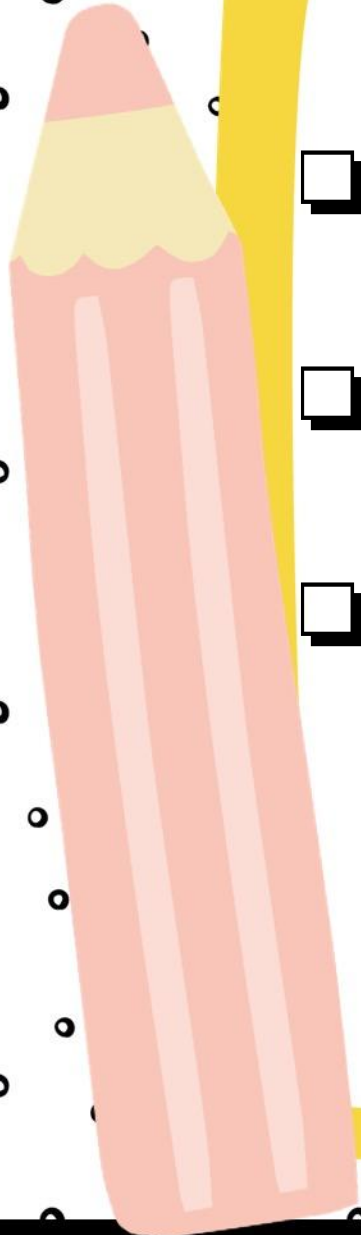
# TECH INFO
