Me with my little sister, Kate.

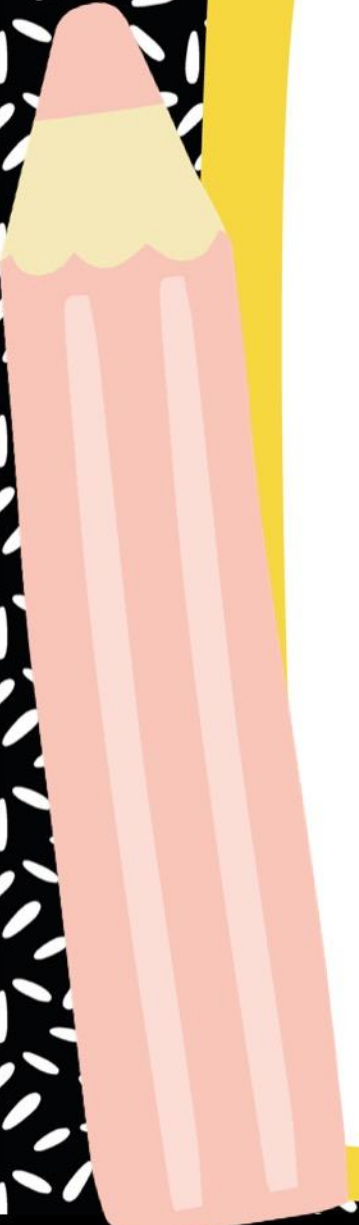

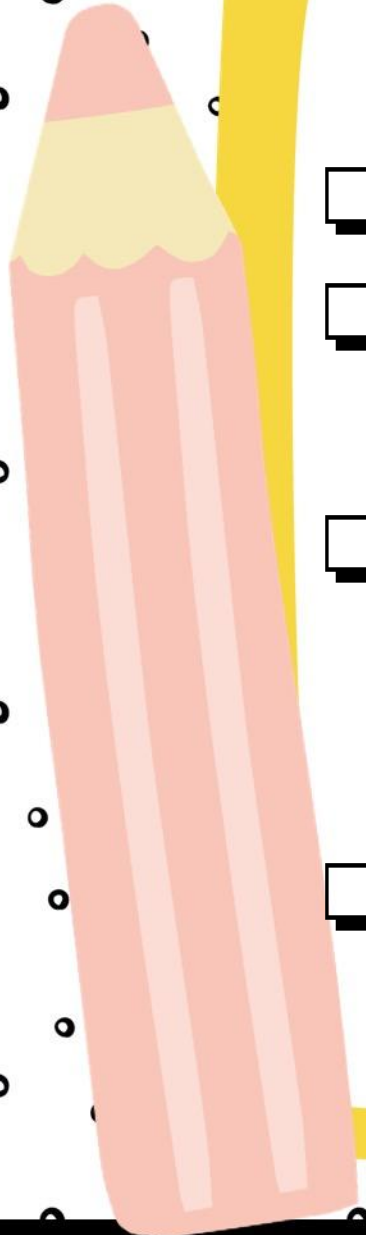

- Be Kind



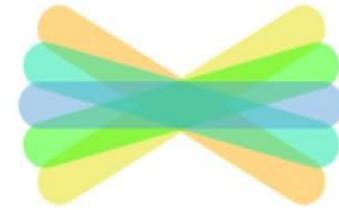
# TAKE-HOME FOLDER

# LUNCH

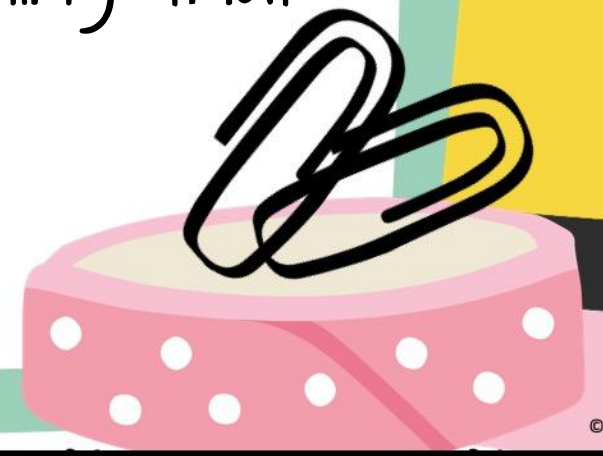
We will be eating lunch in the classroom. Please have your child practice opening their own lunch as much as possible so teachers do not have to touch their food.

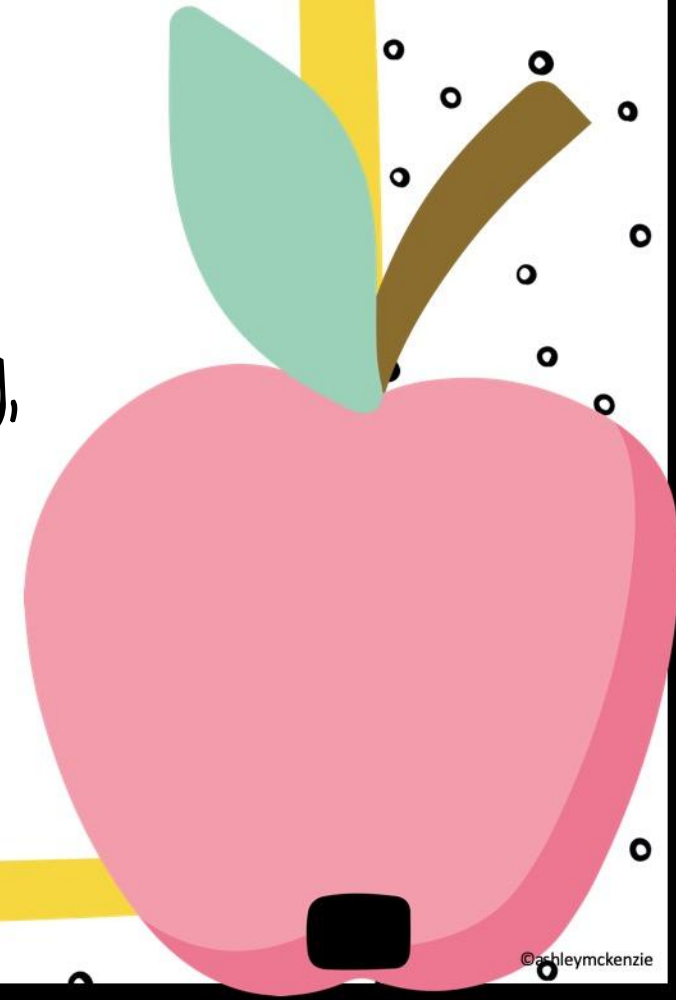
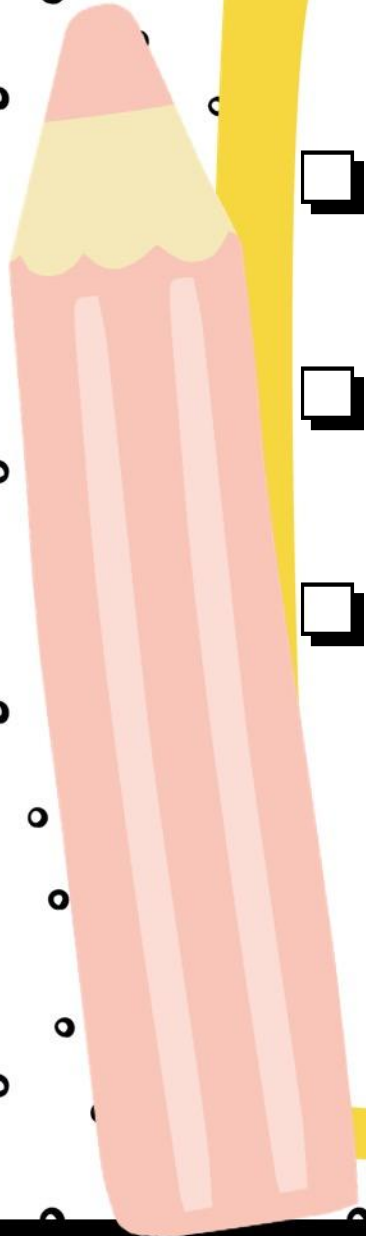
# TECH INFO

- Consider discussing proper handwashing, coughing/sneezing into elbow, and social distancing with your child.



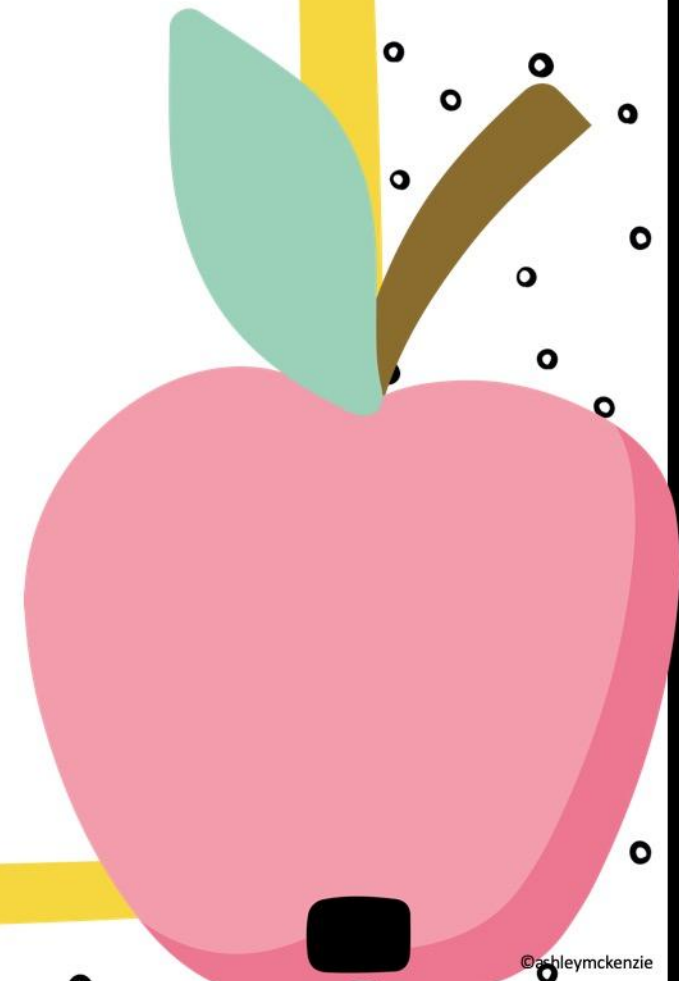
# DISMISSAL
